Meeting Minutes: Motion to accept the minutes from the meeting on 5/26/2012: 1st: John Jones 2nd: Dennis Dick. **PASSED**

BRICS System Updates:

- Capt. Franke and Technician Vedra presented Powerpoint of system items
 - Statistics 2012 - 7.798 million PTT's
 - 10 busy PTT's for a total of 12 seconds.
- 7.11 Infrastructure system updates are complete. NICE and Dispatch Console upgrades are on hold.
- Lakota East WLHS transmitter and antenna have been co-located on the Shawnee Tower.
- Narrow banding is mandated to be complete by 01/01/2013 for the VHF system
 - The countywide VHF will use a true simulcast through the Microwave network.
 - 5 sites have been selected and will have 4 repeated channels.
- The sites will have 800 Mhz repeated back up channels
 - This provides back up options
- Motorola XTS1500 one time special purchase
 - Public Works/ Administrator Tier portable.
 - Motorola is offering an additional \$200 off per radio through 11/2012. The cost is \$1200 per radio.
 - The state contract has been changed to 30% off list price for portable radios.
- Maintenance
 - Most of the subscriber radios are now out of warranty.
 - Less than 50 radios have been sent to the Depot for repairs. Most are being completed in house.
 - BRICS is looking at becoming an FM Certified facility.
- System Budget
 - Portable radio batteries are the agencies responsibility.
 - BRICS would like Advisory Board input on prioritizing budget items.

Committee Updates:

- PSAP - Dennis Dick reports they are still reviewing the Plain Talk and Pursuit Policies.
 - They will continue to meet monthly.

- Chief Goller reports the Fire Communications still working on emergency button issue and transmit on "E" bank issue.
- LE Committee was not present for a report.
- Plain Talk Committee was not present for a report.

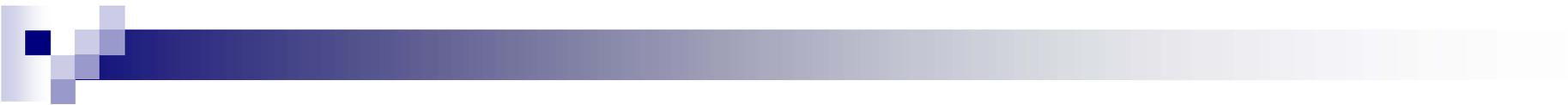
Statistic from the last 12 months include the 7.11 system upgrade, during which approximately six weeks of data were not captured.

- 15 channels (13 active) at 14 towers



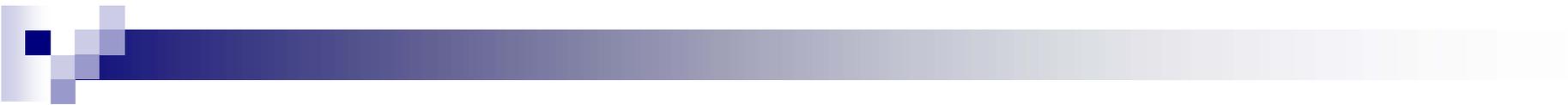

- Console replacement and NICE logging upgrade are on hold due to a “stop ship” on a hardware component and related software



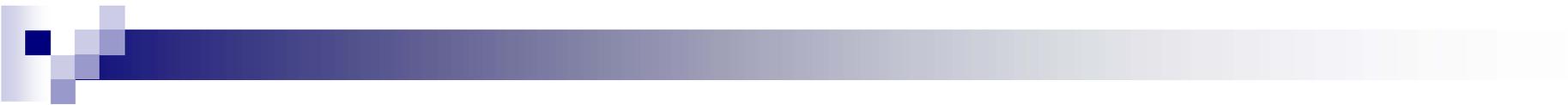

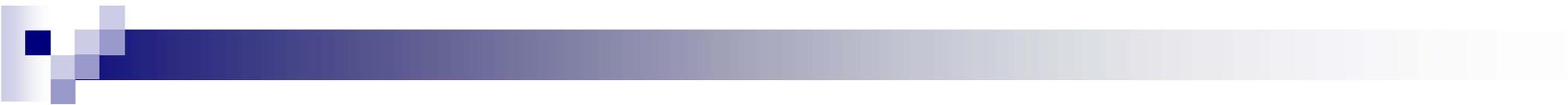

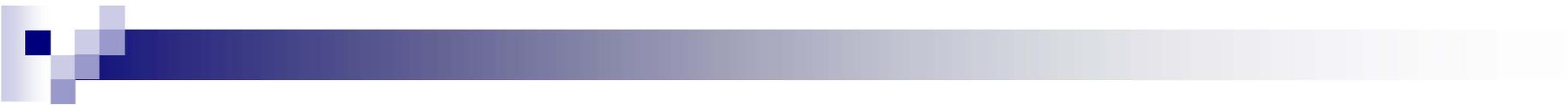
- FCC: Must be complete before 1/1/2013

County Narrowbanding and Conventional Improvement Project

■ Vision

- Establish and maintain a reliable, robust and narrowband-compliant county-wide radio system that provides:
 - interoperability with conventional neighbors,
 - redundancy during trunked radio failures,
 - and capabilities to alert fire stations, personnel and weather sirens.

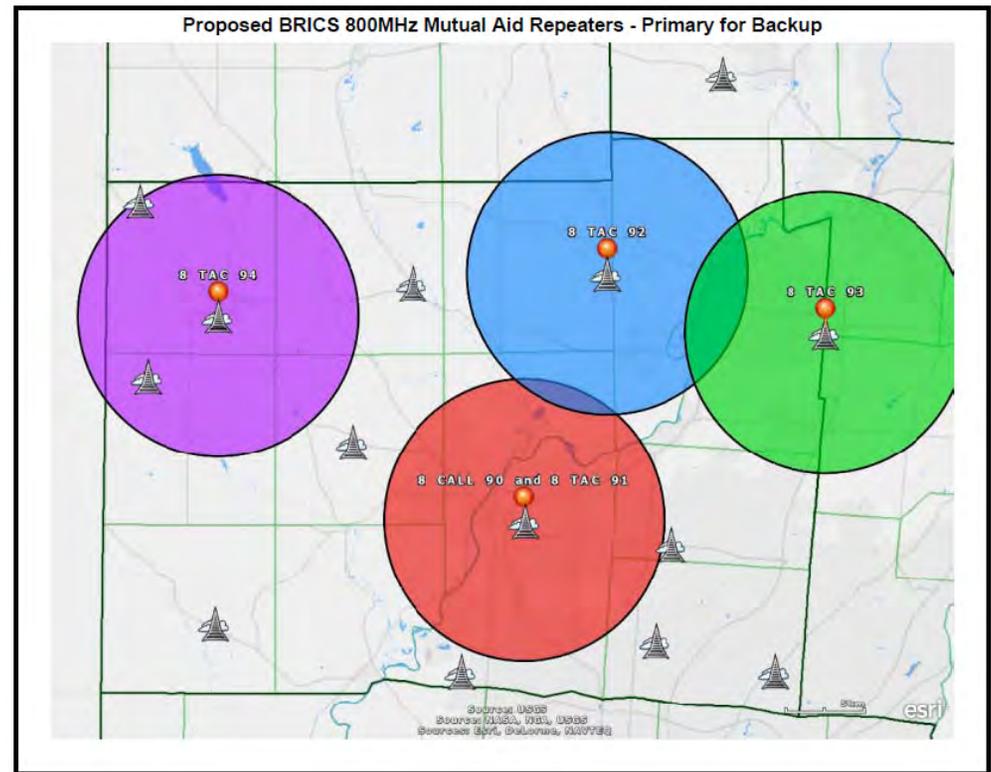


NCIP Project Scope

- Establish new, narrowband compliant county-wide VHF system
 - Improve capacity, coverage and reliability over existing system
 - Use existing, government-owned tower sites (reduce or eliminate leased site costs)
- Modify existing microwave network to support conventional system
 - Reduce or eliminate leased telephone line costs
- Decommission wideband VHF systems and vacate sites

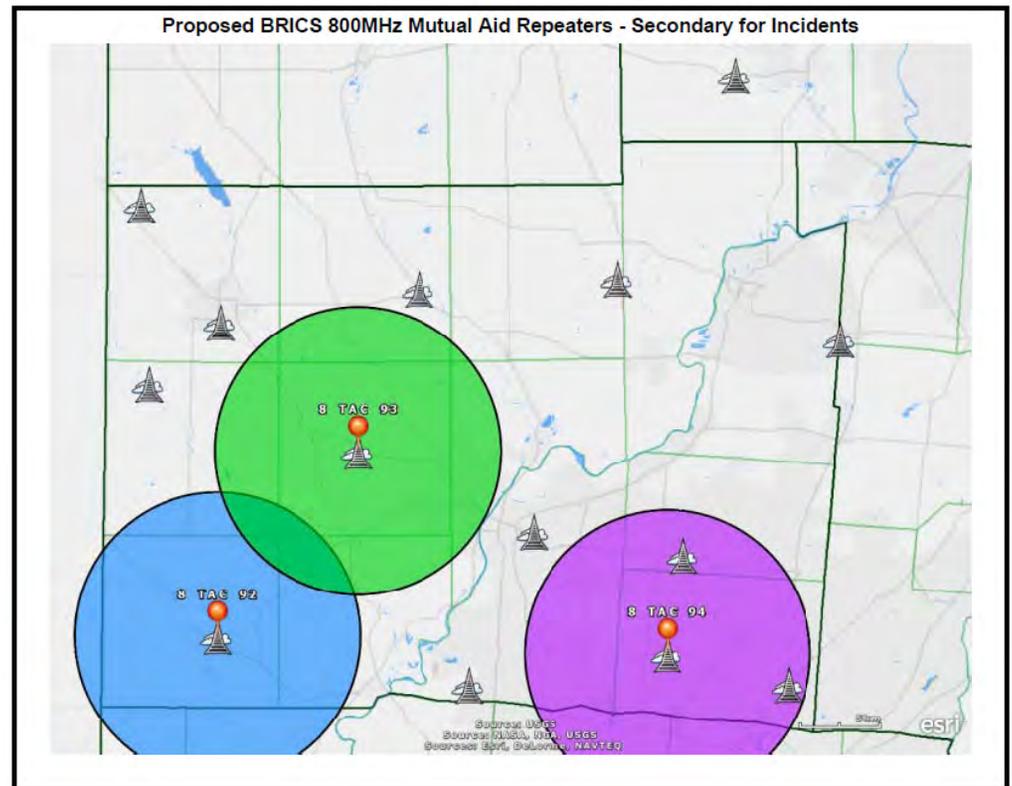
Proposed 800MHz Conventional Sites Primary Sites for Backup

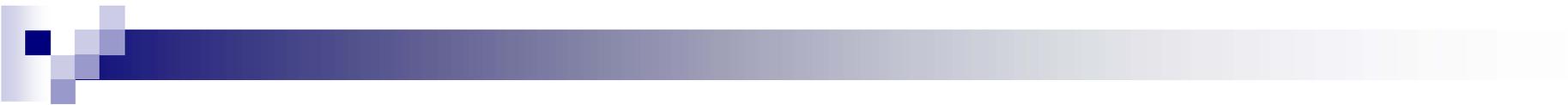
- Set up national mutual aid channel repeaters at four sites with five channels
- Will provide backup options in the event of a trunked system failure



Proposed 800MHz Conventional Sites Secondary Sites for Incidents

- Three more sites with duplicated national channels, to be used for a specific incident as opposed to backup





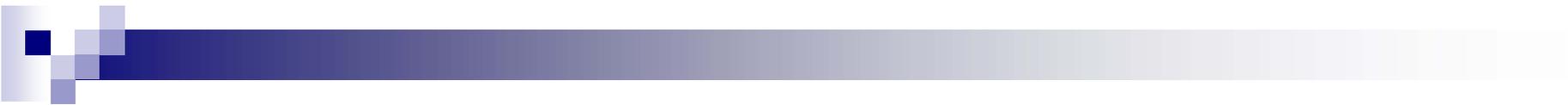
