BRICS RADIO REPROGRAMMING

INSTRUCTIONS FOR RADIO USERS:

Law Enforcement Radio Users

UPGRADE TO RADIO SYSTEM

In early September, the BRICS 800MHz radio system will be upgraded and interconnected with the statewide MARCS-IP radio system. A July 16th letter to users explained this in further detail. If you haven't read it, visit:

Your radios are being reprogrammed to prepare for this change. As far as your radio is concerned, on a September date (to be announced), the current radio system will turn off and a new system will be turned on. At that point, you'll be directed to switch to a different channel/talkgroup in your radio that will be the new place to communicate on the upgraded system.

TEMPORARY TALKGROUPS UNTIL THE SWITCH

Beginning with your radio reprogramming, the talkgroups on the current system are located in the "back" of your radio (e.g. to the left of Zone A, using the ZONE button and the left arrow to get there). The temporary zones are numbered instead of lettered (Zones 1 through 4).

IMPORTANT TO NOTE DURING THIS TEMPORARY PERIOD:

- To **navigate to/from zones 1 4**, press the ZONE soft key and then use the left or right arrows (left, if you are coming from Zone A). Press the home button to lock in your zone selection.
- Your A-B-C switch navigates between zones A through C on the **new** system. Avoid manipulating this switch. If you are on Zone 1 and move your A-B-C switch, it will change you to the selection. You will need to use the ZONE soft key and arrows to get back to Zone 1.
- All **emergency alarms** for all public safety radios in the county will revert to BC CALLING during this temporary period due to limitations and outages of the dispatch consoles. Dispatchers will be responsible for identifying whether the user with the emergency belongs to them, and responding appropriately.
- Zone 1 isn't an exact mirror of your old Zone A, and so on. Take note of the changes. You may not have had LE TAC talkgroups in your Zone A before, for instance.
- Disruptions to dispatch centers during this period may mean that the dispatchers are without access to as many channels as they normally have. In a situation where they may have normally provided you with an alternate talkgroup, they may be unable. Follow their instructions, and understand that it may not be business as usual.

THE SWITCH IN SEPTEMBER 2014

Future updates from us will communicate the details of our September transition to the upgraded radio system. If the appropriate person in your organization didn't receive our July 16th letter by email, let us know so they can be added to our distribution list.

At the designated time in September, all radio users will begin using the new system in the normal 'lettered' zones.

The new template is a bit different from the old – some things are in different places, and talkgroup names have changed to fit the format required to work on a statewide system. We'll send out on explanation of these changes before the switch.




KNOBS AND BUTTONS ON THE XTS-5000

Changing zones during this temporary period will require use of the menu soft key under where the screen says "ZONE", and then the use of the left or right arrows. When you find the zone you're looking for, press the home button. Avoid use of the A-B-C switch.

The **emergency button** takes you to BC CALLING to sound the alarm during this temporary programming period. Once we switch to the new system and you're operating out of the lettered zones, the emergency button will work like you're used to.

Your **scan list** is reset to defaults when your radio is reprogrammed. If you had customized your list, you will need to add the talkgroups.
