

INSTRUCTIONS FOR RADIO USERS:

Fort Hamilton Hospital Radio Users

UPGRADE TO RADIO SYSTEM

In early September, the BRICS 800MHz radio system will be upgraded and interconnected with the statewide MARCS-IP radio system. A July 16th letter to users explained this in further detail. If you haven't read it, visit:

Your radios are being reprogrammed to prepare for this change. As far as your radio is concerned, on a September date (to be announced), the current radio system will turn off and a new system will be turned on. At that point, you'll be directed to switch to a different channel/talkgroup in your radio that will be the new place to communicate on the upgraded system.

TEMPORARY TALKGROUPS UNTIL THE SWITCH

Temporarily, the talkgroups shown in orange are the only ones available to you on the current radio system.

You will operate in: Zone C, Channel # 6 (ER FRTHAM)



Make sure that the A-B-C switch and channel knob are correctly set.

THE SWITCH IN SEPTEMBER 2014

Future updates from us will communicate the details of our September transition to the upgraded radio system. If the appropriate person in your organization didn't receive our July 16th letter by email, let us know so they can be added to our distribution list.

At the designated time, all radio users will begin using the talkgroups with a white background on the upgraded system.

After the upgrade, you will use: Zone A, Channel #4 (09 FRTHAM)



KNOBS AND BUTTONS ON THE MOTOROLA XTS-5000 MODEL II RADIO



With the radio powered on, use the A-B-C zone select toggle switch and the 1 through 16 channel knob to select the proper talkgroup. The screen will display the zone letter and talkgroup name on the same line. Press and hold the PTT button to talk, and release to listen.

The top side button repeats the channel name announcement. Side buttons 1 and 2 are not used.

The emergency button is disabled on your hospital radios.
