

DISCOUNT ON XTS-1500 NON-PUBLIC-SAFETY RADIO

OCTOBER 11TH, 2012

An improvement to Motorola's state contract pricing, and a temporary sales promotion has resulted in the lowest price we've seen yet for the Motorola XTS-1500 Model 1.5 portable radio.

RADIO DETAILS

This radio is commonly used by our public works and utility agencies. It would also be suitable for government administration, school districts and public transit users.

This radio is physically smaller than the XTS-5000 used by public safety, and is not capable of holding the larger template of channels and talkgroups needed to interoperate with neighboring law enforcement, fire and EMS agencies.

For non-public-safety agencies, it works well, holding the three zones of BRICS talkgroups and three zones of national mutual aid channels that comprise the template they need.

CURRENT PROMOTION

Motorola has a \$200 per radio discount available, expiring November 15th 2012.

This brings the per radio cost to: \$1,189.80

The \$1,189 price includes the radio and the software options needed to operate on our system, as well as the battery, programming and engraving.

OPTIONS: Single-unit chargers, multi-unit (six radios) chargers, and vehicular chargers are an option and not included in the above price.
